### **Our suggestions:**

**Parishes and groups** wishing to visit San Domenico in Bologna on the occasions of the celebration of the eighth centenary of the death of St Dominic, co-patron of Bologna, can make use of the services offered by the Ospitalità San Tommaso, which is run by the Dominican friars.

- Visiting days are Monday, Wednesday and Friday; the timetable is previously agreed and may also include lunch or dinner;
- In general the visit will take place as follows:
  - a. Meet at the Ospitalità San Tommaso, Via S. Domenico 1, Bologna, at the agreed time;
  - b. Film on the art treasures of the Dominican complex, with reference to the life and spirituality of St Dominic (one hour);
  - c. You may have lunch or dinner, €18.00 per head (the menu includes a first course of your choice, a second course of your choice, vegetables, drinks, dessert and coffee).
  - d. Prayer in the Basilica, led by the Parish Priest: Mass, or Vespers with the friars, or worship at the tomb of St Dominic.
